SafeCall wireless call system

The Safecall Wireless Nursecall system is an advanced wireless call system offering simply, fast and easy installation.

Wireless Nurse Call offers greater flexibility for users. It is a secure, professional system using the dedicated Pan European 869Mhz alarm frequency in conjunction with Listen Before Talk anti collision technology to ensure patient safety. With its unique two-way system, the call point transmits until it receives acceptance of the call from the display panel, ensuring that all calls are received securely.

The system offers:

- A secure alarm frequency channel
- Can ensure its alarm signal is received every time by a two way acknowledgment
- Lets a member of staff check for the next call from any patient call point
- Provides the option of attending staff ID recording, allowing you to record staff location and efficiency

Flexible

Wireless radio systems give all the functionality of a hardwired system but with the added benefit of complete flexibility. The alarm system goes wherever the patient is; the patient does not have to be tied to the one bed location. The 'wire less' nature of the system allows the call points to be located and then re-located in any required location, without the need of an engineering call out. And 'wire free' means disruption when installing is kept to a minimum for patients and keeps installation costs very low.

Anti-microbial built in

The Safecall system has anti-microbial additives in all surfaces and buttons that are handled or touched, helping to reduce the risk of infection.

System components

SC50 – Safecall Nursecall display panel

Simple to install and use the Safecall system is based around a Nursecall display panel, with a 15" TFT flat screen. Information is displayed in clear full text layout with the option of a mapping facility and bespoke standby screen graphics. A battery back up giving up to 4 hours back up power is also supplied with the unit.

Detailed information including type of call and location of call, are displayed on the panel along with the status of the call. Each call type is allocated a different sounder tone to help staff identify the priority level. Call location can then be displayed on an optional floor plan screen along with the Patients name and further short medical information.

SC45/SC46 – Safecall Nursecall transmitter

The Safecall Nursecall transmitters incorporate the latest wireless technology. Calls are acknowledged by a reassurance LED, sounder and a status message on a clear high quality led display. Buttons are colour coded to the latest HTM and have anti-microbial additives to reduce infection risk.

The Nursecall transmitter will also display a 'Next Call Waiting' message enabling staff to quickly respond to the next call and thus save time not having to return to the staff station.

The unit is supplied with a wall mounted bracket which can also incorporate a cradle to hold the Safecall pear push unit. The Pear push unit is securely locked in to the Nursecall transmitter and has a tamper alarm should it be removed. Further monitoring devices and accessories can also be plugged in to the three sockets on the Nursecall transmitter.

SC45 – Safecall Nursecall transmitter with pull cord and mounting bracket is ideally suited for WC & bathroom locations.

SC46 – Safecall Nursecall transmitter with mounting bracket, Pear Push and cradle can be used in patient rooms and wards.



SC47/SC48 – Safecall Pear push unit for use with Nursecall transmitter

The Safecall Pear push unit can be supplied separately with 3 & 4 meter lead lengths. The Pear push unit is plugged in to the Nursecall transmitter and gives reassurance to less mobile patients that they still have access to make a call.

Further system components for Safecall include Staff attack 'buddy' units, Mobile pendants for patient use and hard wired over door audio visual lamp sounders.
